<p>Pwrpas y cyfarfod oedd trafod e-bost a dderbyniwyd oddi wrth Oaktree Environmental a oedd yn gweithredu ar ran cwmni Hogan yn mynegi eu bwriad i gyflwyno cais cynllunio i ehangu'r chwarel yng Ngwalchmai. Sioc yn dilyn ffrwydro. Daeargrydiau l'w teimlo mewn tai a pherchnogion yn pryderu am y difrod anweladwy i'w tai. 2. Sawl ffrwydrad y diwrnod y rhagwelir ac ar ba amser o'r dydd y digwydd y ffrwydradau? Dymuna'r Cynghorwyr i hyn gael ei gynnwys yn y cais cynllunio. 3. Pryderon difrifol am fwy o lorïau trwm yn mynd trwy'r pentref. Dymuna'r Cynghorwyr weld ymrwymiad pendant yn eich cais cynllunio i gyfeirio lorïau a fydd eisïau mynediad I, a mynd allan o'r chwarel i ddefnyddio'r A55 yn hytrach na'r A5. 4. Beth yw'r orïau gwaith? Mae 12 awr y diwrnod i'w weld yn ormodol. Dymuna'r Cynghorwyr i'r orïau gwaith gael eu cynnwys yn y cais cynllunio. 5. Dymuna'r Cynghorwyr wybod faint o graig fal sydd yng nghronfa dir Ynys Môn ar hyn o bryd. 6. Dymuna'r Cynghorwyr wybod beth a olygir gan "buffer zone" a sut mae'n gweithio. 7. Dymuna'r Cynghorwyr bwysleisio eu gobaith bod gwaith i bobl leol yn wir olygu gwaith i bobl leol. <p>Y mater i'w roi ar agenda'r cyfarfod nesaf ar gyfer ei ail-drafod.</p>	<p>The purpose of the meeting was to discuss an email received from Oaktree Environmental acting on behalf of Hogans, stating their intention to present a planning application to extend the Gwalchmai quarry. In order to comply with the relevant regulations regarding publicity, it is necessary for the company to circulate documents across several agencies, of which Community Councils are one. The bullet points provided, which summarize the information in the proposed application, were discussed and it was decided to present the following comments/questions to the company:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. After shock of blasting already felt in houses in the area. People are concerned about unseen damage to their properties. 2. How many blasts per day are envisaged and at what times are they likely to take place? Councillors would like this to be included in the planning application. 3. Grave concerns regarding more heavy vehicles travelling through the village. Councillors would like to see a commitment in the planning application to direct vehicles using the quarry to gain entrance to and exit from the quarry via the A55 and not via the A5. 4. What are the working hours? 12 hours seems excessive. The Councillors would like to see the working hours stipulated in the planning application. 5. The Councillors wish to know how much crushed rock is already stocked in the Anglesey land bank. 6. The Councillors wish to know what is meant by "buffer zone" and how does it work? 7. Securing local jobs. The Councillors wish to emphasise that they hope that by local you really mean local. <p>The matter to be put on next meeting's agenda for further discussion.</p>
